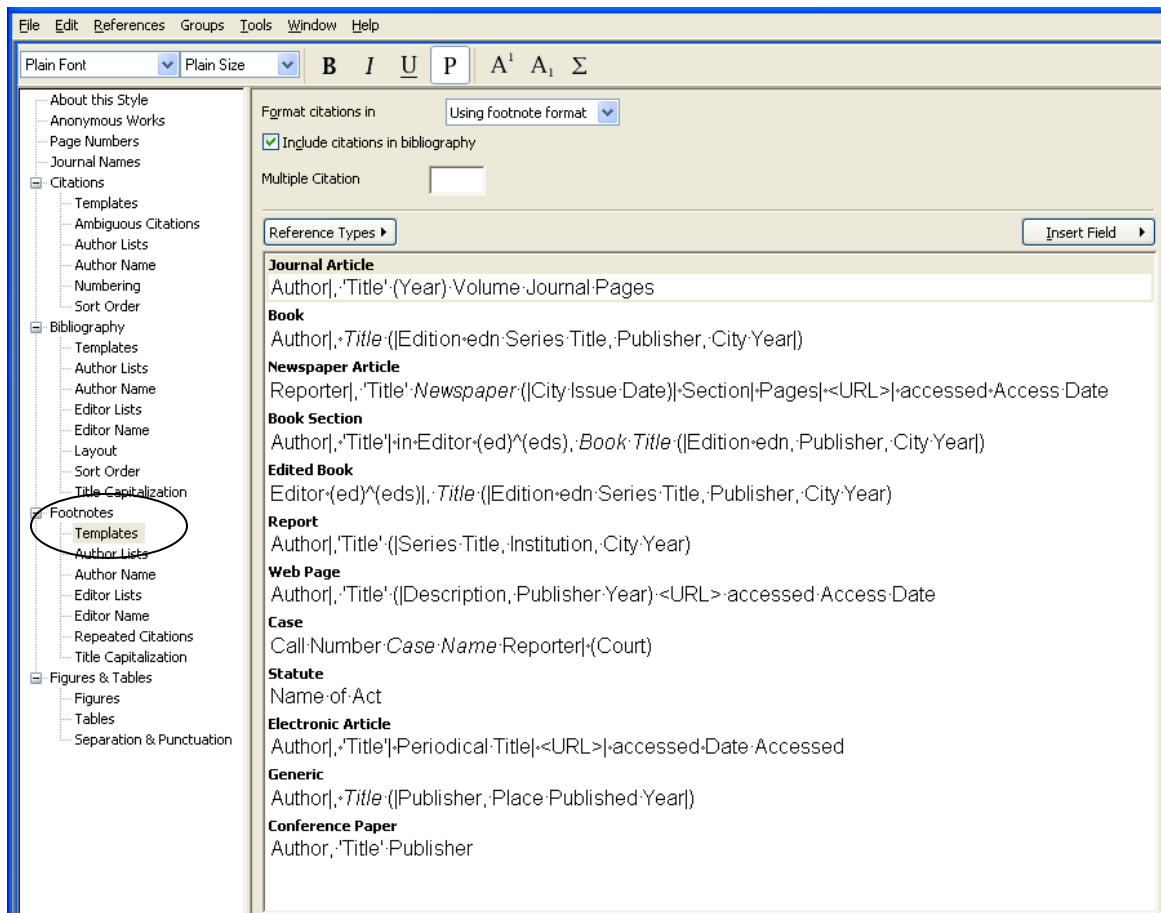


How the OSCOLA for Endnote Style is configured

Begin by opening Edit/ Output Styles/ Choose New Style.

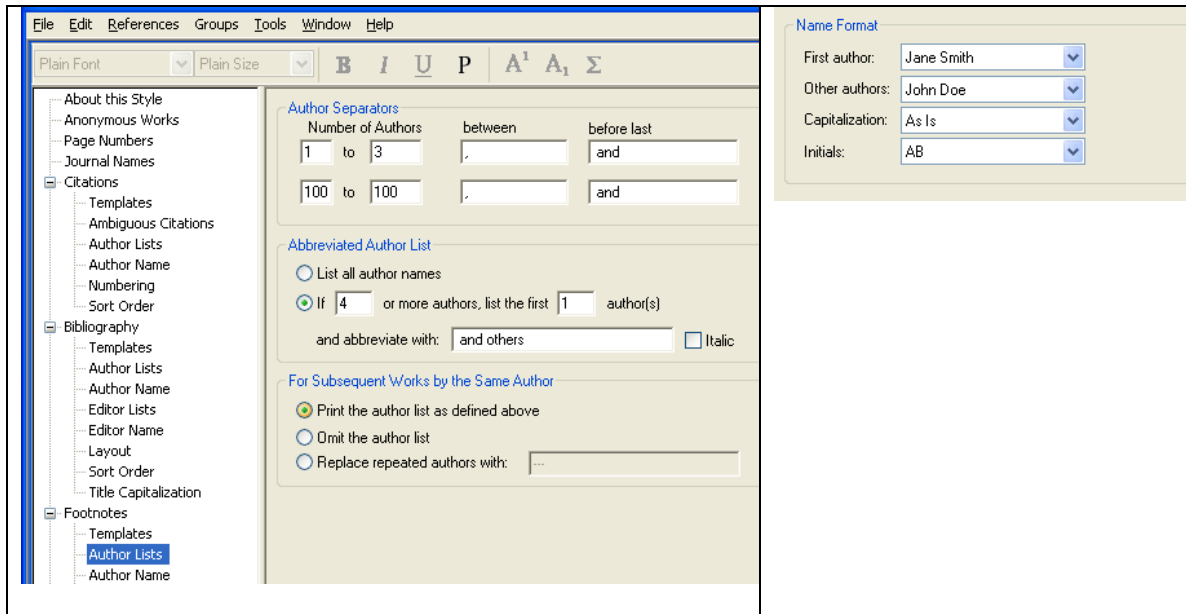
1. Set up the Footnotes Templates

- Down the left menu, under Footnotes, click on Templates.
- Click on Reference Types button to insert a template for the Journal Article Reference types.
- Use Insert Field to insert author, title etc. Use your keyboard to insert punctuation. Use the Special Characters to insert vertical bars (forced separation) and the diamond shape (link adjacent text). These features are explained in the Endnote Help Guide: search for special formatting characters.
- Continue with all the Reference Types shown.
- 'Include citations in bibliography' is not useful while writing, but often essential in the end product. Tick or untick it as required. It is not necessary to format the bibliography templates.

2. The Authors and Editor Lists, and Names
Set as shown. Put a space before 'and' and 'and others'.



3. Repeated citations – set as shown.
